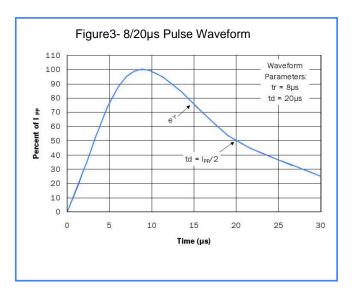


Characteristics Curves
